The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Sanjhauli/ Sanjholi P.S. Case No. 01 of 2022 registered for the offence under Section 302 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Considering the same, the application for bail is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named(Vijay Singh), be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Bikramganj (Rohtas) in connection with Sanjhauli/ Sanjholi P.S. Case No. 01 of 2022.
