APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Sections 302, 120B of the Indian
Penal Code.

3. The allegation against the petitioner along with
others is of killing the son of the informant.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He has
committed no offence. Informant is not an eye-witness of the
alleged occurrence. There is no specific overt act against the
petitioner. During investigation, the petitioner has been
implicated in the present case only on the basis of suspicion. He



further submitted that there is no consistent evidence and no eye-witness of the occurrence to show that the petitioner has involved in the said crime. He is languishing in judicial custody since 13.04.2023.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below in connection with Sabaur P.S. Case No. 517 of 2022.
