- 2 08-08-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.
2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 363/366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. As per the prosecution case, all the FIR named accused persons including the petitioner kidnapped daughter of the informant.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the girl in her 164 Cr.P.C. statement has denied the allegation. She has stated that she was in love with the petitioner and out of her free will, she has married him and is living peaceful married life. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.
5. Considering the 164 Cr.P.C. statement of the victim, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. In the event



of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, mentioned above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate 1st class West Muzaffarpur in Kanti Police Station Case No. 172 of 2021, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
