12 04-07-2023 Learned counsel for the appellant has filed reply to
the counter affidavit filed on behalf of the respondent no. 2 in
Court, which is accepted.

2. The present Miscellaneous Appeal has been filed
against the rejection of injunction petition passed by learned
Sub Judge-X, Patna *vide* order dated 10.03.2014 in Title



Partition Suit No. 251 of 2011.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that he does not want to press this miscellaneous appeal on merit and prays that a direction be given to the concerned lower court to decide the partition suit within a reasonable time. It is further submitted that the evidences of the witnesses have already been started.
