3 11-12-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel
for the Complainant and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable u/s 498(A) of the IPC.

3. The F.I.R. has been lodged by the complainant alleging
that the petitioner along with other accused persons tortured her
over dowry demand.

4. At the very outset, it is submitted by learned counsel for
the petitioner that the parties have compromised the matter.

5. Learned counsel for the O.P. No.2 has not denied this fact.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case,
since the parties have compromised the case, let the above



named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Complaint Case No.218 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
