seeking the following reliefs:-

“1.(i) For issuance of appropriate writ for quashing the result of Notary Public selection of 204 published by State of Bihar, through Department of Law, Govt. of Bihar, Patna.

(ii) For issuance of appropriate writ / direction / order commanding the State of Bihar, and its authorities to publish press advertisement for appointment of Notary Public under the State of Bihar including the 4% disable persons as per office memorandum issued by Ministry of



Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Personnel and Training dated 17-05-2022, Govt. of India, New Delhi."
