2. The petitioner has filed the present writ application challenging the order of termination from the post of “Prakhand Teacher” posted at Upgraded Middle School, Malhani Tola, Hasna, District- Supaul.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at the time of filing of writ application, the District Teachers Appellate Authority was not functioning in the Supaul District.

District Teachers Appellate Authority is functioning in Supaul District.
