“1.That the present writ petition has been preferred for issuance of writ/writs, order / orders, direction / directions, to the respondents court below to take step in accordance with law for disposal of the matter, which is pending by way of Title Suit No. 290/2009, almost about six years will complete, but the entire suit is on the possession when it was filed in the year 2009 only due to motivated interest of the concerned party and lack of judicial discretion, so that the
