The appellants are accused in connection with



Barbiga P.S. Case No. 148 of 2022 registered under Sections 147/149/341/323/504 of I.P.C., Section 27 of the Arms Act and Sections 3(i)(r)(s)/3(1)(zac) of SC/ST (prevention of Atrocities) Act.

Submission of learned counsel for the appellants is that appellants are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. There is no specific allegation against the appellants. Further he submits that there is case and counter case between the parties.
