following relief:-

*"1) To issuance an appropriate writ preferably in
the nature of mandamus commanding upon the
respondent authorities to act accordance in law by
ensuring compliance of their own Letter No. 700
dated 01.07.2021 whereby and whereunder the*



Respondent No. 4 has directed the Respondent No. 5 to ensure construction and encroachment could not be made by the private respondents upon the public land.

ii) To issuance an appropriate writ preferably in the nature of mandamus commanding upon the respondent authorities to act accordance with law by cancelling the Mutation in the name of the private respondents in terms of recommendation contained in Letter No. 694 dated 29.06.2021 issued by Respondent No. 4 to the Respondent No. 2."

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Siwan Sadar, District Siwan for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
