following relief:-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing and commanding the respondents to implement/execute the order dated 22.11.2011 passed by the Learned Deputy Collector Land Reforms Sadar, Darbhanga in L.D.R Case no. 165/2011-12 as the petitioner made application under section 15 of Bihar Land Dispute Resolution Act 2009 for execution of the said order but till date the said order was not executed/implemented.”
