"That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writ (s), order (s) or direction (a) to the respondents to remove the encroachments made over by the private Respondent No 6 to 9 on the



plots of Mauza Masahebpur Thana NO-75 Khata No.- 94 Khesra No- 277 pertaining to its area 0.72 Acres the landed in having its nature Rasta Anabad Sarvsadharan in Khatiyani by construing a Sant Ravidas Mandir and in this regard the proceeding since 2017 has been continue but the encroachment is still existing."

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent-authorities for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
