4 14-03-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to
remove the defects, if any, within three weeks.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323,
354, 376, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and later on
added Section 302, 120B, 201/34 of the IPC.

As per FIR, petitioner caught the hand of the
informant's sister-in-law and took her in one room with
intention to rape her and started misbehaving having put hand in
her upper cloth.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the



petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that there is no specific overt act against the petitioner. He submits that the petitioner is a government servant. Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed the supplementary affidavit stating therein that the mother of the informant and sister-in-law have filed a petition before the court below on 09.01.2023 in which they denied the petitioner's involvement in the alleged incident. He submits that there is specific allegation against co-accused Pappu Singh who is already in judicial custody. He further submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Bagaha (Mahila) P.S. Case No. 14 of 2022,



subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of
the Cr.P.C.
