- 2 04-10-2023 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner had filed an application for issuance of arms license in the year, 2022, however, the District Magistrate, Rohtas at Sasaram, has not considered the same till date.
2. The learned counsel for the Respondent-State submits that in case, the petitioner has filed an application for grant of arms license and the same is still pending, it shall be disposed off, within a fixed time frame.
