ORAL ORDER

6 05-07-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
counsel for the informant and learned APP for the State.

It appears from order dated 20.10.2022, that petitioner was granted provisional bail by another Bench of this Court for a period of six months and with consent of both the parties, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Center, Patna High Court, Patna.

A report dt. 16.3.2023 regarding mediation from the concerned authority has been received from which it appears that mediation has failed.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the informant that informant seeks some maintenance for her survival as she is



a housewife and she is unable to maintain herself and also she is unable to bear education of her child.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, on instructions, submits that petitioner is ready to give Rs. ten thousand per month as maintenance from this month, subject to furnishing bank account number by the informant to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the informant is directed to furnish account number of the informant to the petitioner within a period of one week from today.

On receipt of the bank account number of the informant, the petitioner shall deposit Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) in first week of every month commencing from July, 2023 as maintenance in the account furnished by the informant.

The aforesaid payment will be subject to any order passed in the maintenance case for final settlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that opposite party never allow the petitioner to meet his child.

Learned counsel for the informant, on instructions undertakes that informant will facilitate the petitioner to meet his child.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, the



provisional bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated
20.10.2022 is hereby confirmed.

The application stands allowed.
