Further submission is that since the petitioner has
retired in the year 2010, he may be given liberty to file a writ
petition with specific prayer to get his GPF paid.

So far as the present case is concerned, this Court
does not find any error in the order of learned Additional
Sessions Judge-14, Patna passed on 20.5.2015.

It goes without saying that if the petitioner has any



grievance on the civil side, he always has remedy to pursue the same for redressal of his just grievances.

The petition stands disposed of.
