3 20-09-2023 Heard the parties.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 498A, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Petitioners, who are the in-laws of the informant are said to have assaulted the informant and ousted her from her matrimonial house.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no



offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. Petitioners are the in-laws of the petitioners and there is no specific overt act against them. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as there is no specific overt act against the petitioners, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Nimchak Bathani P.S. Case No.76 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
