APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, the petitioner along with other co-accused persons entered into the house of the informant and assaulted the informant, his son & his wife by means of lathi danda and farsa. The son of the informant died during course of treatment.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. The alleged occurrence took place in the background of land dispute and the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. From perusal



of F.I.R., no specific overt-act attributed to the petitioner rather general and omnibus allegation of assaulting leveled against him. Moreover, similarly situated co-accused namely, Siphat Lal Singh has already been granted bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dt. 26.9.2022 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 68974 of 2021 and in support of this Annexure-3 has been annexed with this petition. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and languishing in judicial custody since 4.5.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Ladaniya P.S. Case No. 197 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M.1st Class, Madhubani.
