A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, it is alleged that the documents produced by the petitioners to procure the job was totally forged.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that



the petitioners have original certificate and not committed any such offences as alleged in the F.I.R.. He further submits that the petitioners were terminated from the service, it is clear from the F.I.R. itself. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Lakhisarai P.S. Case No.105 of 2023, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
