12 23-08-2023 The writ petition was filed regarding the fixation of quota for promotion of Agriculture Inspectors to the post of Assistant Professor. The University recommended 5% quota to be considered to the Agriculture Inspectors, which has been rejected by the Chancellor. In such circumstances, the writ petition has become infructuous. However, we leave liberty to the petitioners to challenge the orders of the Chancellor, if they so desire.

The writ petition would stand dismissed with the above reservation.
