4 03-11-2023 1. The petitioner has approached this Court being aggrieved by the ex-parte order passed by Chairman, Bihar State Madarsa Education Board, containing Memo No. 3627-32 dated 15.04.2019 by which the affiliation of the petitioners/Madarsa were cancelled.

2. Learned counsel for the Board submits that in meeting, which was dated 17.03.2023, *vide* Resolution No. 3, the Madarsa Board has decided to restore the affiliation of all such Madarsas including the petitioners.
