2 08-05-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief:-

*“1. That this is an application for issuance of writ
in nature of mandamus commanding respondents
to get the obstruction put by respondent no. 4 and 5
on an area of 4 decimals of plot no. 1787 of Khata
no. 431 situated at village-Turhipatti which is
being used as road by Public including petitioner
on amongst others.”*

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner
seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks



liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
