ORAL ORDER

2 16-08-2023 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P for the State.

3. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Shahpur Patory (Mohanpur O.P) P.S. Case No. 334 of 2023 dated 16.05.2023 registered for the offence punishable u/s 363 and 366 of the Indian Penal Code.

4. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner boarded on a motorcycle is alleged to have abducted the daughter of the informant forcibly with ill motive.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this



case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submitted that the victim was not forced to have illicit relationship with another persons. As per the F.I.R, the victim is a major girl. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 17.05.2023.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner by submitting that the victim in her statement recorded u/s 164 of the Cr.P.C has stated that she was standing near the house, 2-3 persons boarded on motorcycle came and they forcibly shut her mouth and carried her forcibly.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Samastipur in connection with Shahpur Patory (Mohanpur O.P) P.S. Case No. 334 of 2023.

8. The application stands allowed.
