APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Sections 356 and 379 of the
Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, the informant was going
home, in the meantime, four persons came on two motorcycles
snatched his mobile, Aadhar Card and other articles.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He has
committed no offence. Petitioner was not apprehended on spot.
The name of the petitioner has come into light, on the basis of
confessional statement of co-accused Sudhanshu Kumar, which



has got no evidentiary value in the eyes of law. He submitted that the as alleged recovered motorcycle, Bearing No. BR31AQ-8256 and mobile phone belongs to the petitioner with their valid documents and are annexed with annexure-2 series. No incriminating/looted articles have been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. He is languishing in judicial custody since 06.06.2023.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below in connection with Sakra P.S. Case No. 262 of 2023.
