ORAL ORDER

2 18-08-2023 At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the anticipatory bail application with regard to petitioner Nos. 3 and 4.

2. Permission is granted.

3. The anticipatory bail application with regard to above named petitioner Nos. 3 and 4 is dismissed as withdrawn.



4. Petitioner Nos. 1, 2, 5, 6 and 7 apprehend arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 341, 323, 308, 325, 324, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

5. Allegation against these petitioners is that they assaulted informant and others by means of *lathi*, *danda* and iron rod. Doctor has found the injuries caused by these petitioners to be simple in nature.

6. Considering the simple nature of injuries, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner Nos. 1, 2, 5, 6 and 7 in the event of their arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Darbhanga in connection with Ghanshyampur P. S. Case No. 48 of 2023, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

7. This case is disposed of.
