ORAL ORDER

- 2 09-08-2023 1. Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned A.P.P. for the State.
3. The petitioners have preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Sheikhpura (Sirari O.P.) P.S. Case No. 302 of 2023 dated 17.5.2023 registered for the offence punishable u/s 8, 20(b)(ii)(a), 25 of the NDPS Act.



4. As per the prosecution case, 1 kg of Ganja is alleged to have recovered from the house of the co-accused, Niranjan Singh. The petitioners were apprehended on the spot.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioners have no concern with the alleged recovery. The seized contraband is of small quantity. The petitioners have clean antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioners are in custody since 17.5.2023.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioners.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioners above-named, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Sheikhpura in connection with Sheikhpura (Sirari O.P.) P.S. Case No. 302 of 2023.



8. The application stands allowed.
