ORAL ORDER

2 17-08-2023 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P for the State.

3. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Supaul P.S. Case No. 160 of 2023 dated 02.03.2023 registered for the offences punishable u/s 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

4. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-accused persons along with 2-3 unknown miscreants intercepted the informant and other cattle traders and looted Rs. 1,15,000/- in cash and some other valuables.



5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The other co-accused person has already been granted bail by the Co-ordinate Bench *vide* order dated 03.07.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 33626 of 2023. The petitioner is accused in one more criminal case as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 03.03.2023

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Supaul in connection with Sapaul P.S. Case No. 160 of 2023.

8. The application stands allowed.
