APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for bail in a case instituted for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 307, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per allegation in the FIR, informant was coming from the house of maternal grandmother in the meantime, accused persons abused him and on protest, accused Guddu Kewat opened fire which hit right side of his stomach.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. They have committed no offence. Specific allegation of opening fire



is against co-accused Guddu Kewat, who has already been enlarged on bail vide order dated 24.7.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 40292 of 2023. As per injury report, injury is caused by hard and sharp metallic object. General and omnibus allegations have been levelled against these petitioners. Both the petitioners are languishing in judicial custody for more than three months.

The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The above named petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patna City, Patna in connection with Mehandiganj P.S. Case No. 120 of 2022.
