3 19-01-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for bail in a case registered
for the offence punishable under sections 302/34 of the Indian
Penal Code and section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per allegation in the FIR, petitioner and other co-
accused committed murder of informant's father by opening
indiscriminate firing.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in
this case merely on suspicion. There is no eye witness of the
present occurrence. No overt act has been attributed tot he
petitioner. Similarly three other co-accused persons have already
been granted bail by another Bench vide order dated 2.09.2022,



07.12.2022 and 23.03.2022 passed in Cr. Misc. Nos. 26864/2022, 44441/2022 and 45316/2022 respectively. Petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 30.07.2021.

The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM-1, Madhepura in connection with Shankarpur P.S. Case No. 152 of 2020.
