APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Sections 457 and 380 of the
Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, in the night some
unknown miscreants have broken the gate lock of the
informant's house and theft away all the goods, ornaments, cash
and necessary documents.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He has
committed no offence. Petitioner is not named in the FIR and
the same has been lodged against unknown persons. The name
of the petitioner has come into light, on the basis of confessional



statement of co-accused Vikash Kumar, which has got no evidentiary value in the eyes of law. Nothing incriminating/looted articles have been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. No T.I. Parade has been done. He is languishing in judicial custody since 22.09.2022.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M.-1st Class, Patna in connection with Budha Colony P.S. Case No. 466 of 2022.
