APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per prosecution case, there has been recovery of
350 liters of cough syrup from two Cars, which was being
driven by petitioner and other co-accused.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He has
committed no offence. Petitioner has apprehended on spot. He
submitted that the petitioner has no concern either with the
seized vehicle or with the cough syrup in question. On the basis



of suspicion and due to his criminal antecedent, he has been falsely implicated in the present case by the police. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. He further submitted that the present case relates to recovery of cough syrup and therefore the same will not come under the provision of Excise Act. He is languishing in judicial custody since 25.06.2023.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below in connection with Government Official Comp. P.S. Case No. 484 of 2023.
