7 15-02-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Vide order dated 16.01.2023, the matter was referred to Mediation Centre, Patna High Court for mediation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been settled between the parties through mediation. This fact is also supported by the learned counsel for the O.P. No.2.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six



weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/-
(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like
amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where
the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with
Rupaspur P.S. Case No.81 of 2020, subject to the conditions as
laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
