3 14-03-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 323 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, petitioner is alleged to have assaulted the informant with sharp edged weapon and thereby caused injury on his back, head and hand.

It is submitted that injury sustained by the informant is simple in nature. As a matter of fact, the petitioner had gone to purchase saree from the shop of informant and during purchase scuffle took place between the parties, as a result of which informant sustained simple injury. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.



Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate VI, Kaimur at Bhabhua in connection with Kudra P.S. Case No. 152 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
