2 16-08-2023 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a
period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

3. The petitioner has preferred this application for
grant of regular bail in connection with Patliputra P.S Case No.
128 of 2023 dated 13.02.2023 registered for the offences
punishable u/s 363 and 366 of the Indian Penal Code.

4. As per the prosecution case, unknown miscreants
are alleged to have kidnapped the minor daughter of the
informant.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner has surfaced up in the self confessional statement. The petitioner is a lady. The victim in her statement recorded u/s 161 of the Cr.P.C has stated that she has married Ram Niwas Choudhary in Rajasthan and she is residing with him and she is not ready to return to her mother's house. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 29.05.2023.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Patna in connection with Patliputra P.S Case No. 128 of 2023.

8. The application stands allowed.
