The present application has been filed for

modification of the order dated 29.04.2022, passed in Cr.

Misc. No. 20688 of 2022, by which the petitioner was



granted anticipatory bail in connection with Excise Case No. 100 of 2022, pending in the court of learned Additional District and Sessions Judge-IX-cum-Special Judge-II, Excise, Aurangabad, and the petitioner was directed to surrender in the court below within a period of twelve weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to some unavoidable reasons the petitioner could not surrender in the court below well within time. It is further submitted that further time may be extended so that the petitioner could surrender in the court below.

Considering the submissions made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner and the grounds mentioned in the modification application, the period of surrender of the petitioner in the court below is extended for a further period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. The rest of the conditions stipulated in the order will be same.

The order dated 29.04.2022, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 20688 of 2022, is modified to the extent as indicated above, subject to removal of the defect(s), as pointed out by



the office within a period of one week.

The present application is disposed of.
