1. Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.
 2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.
 3. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Dumra P.S. Case No. 180 of 2023 dated 4.4.2023 registered for the offences punishable u/s 413, 414 of the IPC.
 4. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-accused persons were apprehended by the police at the residence of one Chhotu Kumar and on search, the police



recovered one mobile phone from the house of the co-accused, Chhotu Kumar which is said to be stolen.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The recovery is from the house of the co-accused. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused, Raju Kumar. The petitioner is accused in two other criminal cases as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 5.4.2023.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Sitamarhi in connection with Dumra P.S. Case No. 180 of 2023.



8. The application stands allowed.
