3 17-10-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
registered for the offence punishable under sections 21(b),
22(b), 25, 29 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

3. According to the prosecution, the petitioner is
alleged to have been apprehended from house of Jagdish Das
and from where 271 bottles of cough syrup of different kind
along with 588 tablets psychotropic drugs were recovered.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has
falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has no
concern with the alleged recovery of cough syrups or
psychotropic drugs. Nothing has been recovered from conscious



possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted the provision of N.D.P.S. Act has not been followed by the prosecution. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail petition and he is languishing in judicial custody since 26.4.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 27 of 2023 arising out of Kanauli P.S. Case No. 40 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge, Supaul.
