The learned counsel for the parties point out that this Court had directed the respondent-authorities to consider the judgment rendered by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court dated 03.03.2017, in CWJC No.384 of 2017 as also the one rendered by the learned Division Bench of this Court on 23.01.2018, in



L.P.A. No.1047 of 2017, and redress the grievances of the petitioner, however, the said judgment dated 23.01.2018, has already stood reviewed by the learned Division Bench of this Court by a judgment dated 07.08.2019, passed in Civil Review No.68 of 2019, and the same is not in favour of the petitioners, hence the present petition has been rendered inefficacious.
