non-compliance of the order dated 30.06.2022 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 5684 of 2021 read with the petitioner's representation dated 08.07.2022.

2. The concerned authority has passed an order dated 21.11.2022 and it is in favour of the petitioner. However, certain monetary issues are concerned, it is yet to be finalized for want of certain funds. In this regard, the concerned authority shall expedite the matter and resolve the issue within a reasonable period of three months from today.

3. With the above observation, the present M.J.C. stands dropped, reserving liberty to the petitioner to file I.A. for revival of this order in the event of non-settling of his grievance.
