APP for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30 (a) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of recovery of total 1.500 liters of liquor from the possession of Shashi Nikhil.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession and he came to be implicated based on confessional statement of Shashi Nikhil in



police custody which does not have any evidentiary value.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Special Excise Judge, Danapur, where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Danapur P.S. Case No. 1049 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
