seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That this is an application for  
issuance of writ in the nature of  
mandamus, order or orders, direction  
or directions, commanding the  
respondents no.-2 to 6 to remove the  
encroachment made on the public  
land vide Thana No. 156, Khata No.  
108, Khesra No. 3620 Area 8 dhur by  
respondents no.- 7 to 9 by erecting  
hut and wall over the same and  
being caused obstruction to the*



*petitioner on going on the road from his house and in that context the father of the petitioner namely Sonalal Singh (deceased) earlier filed a writ application in this Hon'ble Court vide C.W.J.C. No. 13405 of 2015 which was disposed of by this Hon'ble Court on 22.9.2017 with a direction to respondent no.-4 and accordingly in compliance of the said order respondent no.-4 merely done paper work but encroachment has not been removed from the said public land and further appropriate direction may be given to that effect."*

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the District Magistrate-Motihari, East Champaran for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
