The present application has been filed for setting aside the order dated 13.08.2018 passed by the learned Additional District Judge-II, Nawada in Title Appeal No. 19 of 2003, by which the Additional District Judge has allowed the petition dated 06.09.2017, filed by the respondent no. 6 for impleading as a party in place of his wife.

3. In the opinion of this Court, no prejudice will be



caused to the petitioner if the husband of the deceased daughter has been allowed to be added as a party because the appeal shall be decided on merits and merely because the husband has become a party will not give any right to the husband if he has no right in the property of his father-in-law.

4. In view of the above, this application stands dismissed
