The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Tarabari P.S. Case No.68 of 2022 registered under Sections 148, 153, 186, 353, 427, 506 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of the Public Property Act, 1984.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case being the owner of the vehicle. He also submits that the fine imposed by the authority has already been deposited before the Transport Department, Bihar through e-challan as is evident from Annexure 4 to the supplementary affidavit.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the



parties, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of J.M., 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Araria in connection with Tarabari P.S. Case No.68 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
