ORAL ORDER

2 13-01-2023 Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to remove all the defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter within one month.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as the learned APP for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Sugauli P.S. Case No. 291 of 2021, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 341, 323, 307, 379, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that



there is case and counter case. Both the sides have sustained injuries and the injuries sustained by the informant side are simple in nature.

Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks before the learned court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari in connection with Sugauli P.S. Case No. 291 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Office shall ensure that all defects are removed by the petitioners within the stipulated time provided in para-1 hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
