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petitioner is ready to keep the victim with full dignity and honour at his place of posting and he is ready to maintain her.

5. Learned counsel for the informant has submitted that the petitioner has specifically mentioned in paragraph No. 10 of his bail petition that he is ready to keep the victim with full dignity and honour, as such, he may be granted anticipatory bail.
6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks before the learned court below, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Nalanda at Biharsharif in connection with Complaint Case No. 836-C of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
7. **The petitioner is directed to adhere to his words and shall bring back his wife to the place of posting within a period of 10 days from today.**
