4. Petitioners apprehend arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

5. As per prosecution case, there is direct allegation against these petitioners that they along with other accused



persons committed torture and harassment to the informant for dowry. From perusal of the impugned order it appears that petitioner No. 1 has confessed that he has assaulted the informant.

6. Considering the nature of accusation and gravity of the offence, prayer for bail of the petitioners is refused.
