As per the prosecution story, the FIR has been
lodged stating that the petitioner took appointment on the basis
of forged certificate and despite amnesty granted to her, she
chose not to resign and as such, this FIR.

Considering the allegation that has been levelled
against the petitioner that she entered in service on the basis of
forged certificate and despite amnesty chose not to resign even



after lodging of the FIR, she is continuing in service, this Court is not inclined to grant her relief and the application stands rejected.
