3 04-02-2023 Heard Mr. Anil Kumar Choudhary, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Rabindra Priyadarsi, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Bihar State Housing Board, Patna and Ms. Deepika Sharma, learned AC to SC-9 for the State.

2. After few arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ application with liberty to file a detailed application before the Managing Director, Bihar State Housing Board to bring on record all the required documents such as succession certificate as well as money receipt, which was deposited by his father as well as by the heirs of his father, including the petitioner,



pursuant to the allotment of plot No. LP-01 in the year 1996 at Bhagalpur.

3. The present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file fresh application before the Managing Director, Bihar State Housing Board.

4. The Managing Director, Bihar State Housing Board, is directed to dispose of application filed by the petitioner, if any, within a period of three months from the submission of the application.

5. With the above observation and direction, the present writ application is dismissed as withdrawn.
