The petitioners further pray for a Mandamus directing the respondents to grant age relaxation to the petitioners so that they can make an application under Advertisement No. 26/2023 published by the Bihar Public Service Commission, Patna



(hereinafter referred to as the 'BPSC').

2. Mr. Sanjay Pandey, learned counsel for the BPSC has informed that the last date for filling up the examination form was 22nd July, 2023, and today the examinations are being held.
