2. The District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Vaishali at

Hajipur is directed to redress the grievances of the petitioners,

as claimed for in the present writ petition within a period of four



weeks and make payment of all retiral dues in accordance with law without delaying further. In case, he is required the service particulars with respect to the individual petitioners for proper adjudication, the same may be collected by him within the aforesaid period.

3. The petitioners, if so advised, may appear before the District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Vaishali at Hajipur within 1-2 days with respect to redressal of their grievances.

4. With the above observation/direction, the present writ petition is disposed of.
